Can I donate items?

Yes. You can donate items on specific days and times, reach out to us via the Contact Us page on our website at southbaymouth.ca

What type of items are allowed for donation?

We truly appreciate your donation in support of SBCDA initiatives but reserve the right to accept only clean, quality and saleable items. We are unable to accept certain items due to safety concerns, health regulations and disposal fees should they not sell.

Items we cannot accept:

- Any items deemed dangerous by our volunteers including metal gas cans
- Old or damaged books including Encyclopedias
- Items that are broken, soiled or damaged
- Major appliances: large freezers, refrigerators, stoves, microwaves, washing machines, dryers etc.
- Small appliances and power tools that no longer work
- Baby items such as cribs, highchairs, car seats
- Building materials; lumber, tiles, toilets
- Medical supplies and devices
- Helmets, water bottles
- Chemicals, cleaners, paints
- Mattresses, box springs, sofa beds
- Upholstered Furniture
- Used clothing and shoes
- Outdated non-flat screen televisions, computers, printers
- Used auto parts and tires

Note: Anyone that chooses to bring their own goods to sell as mentioned in the flyer are welcome to do so **but must remove all items from the site as the conclusion of the sale.**
